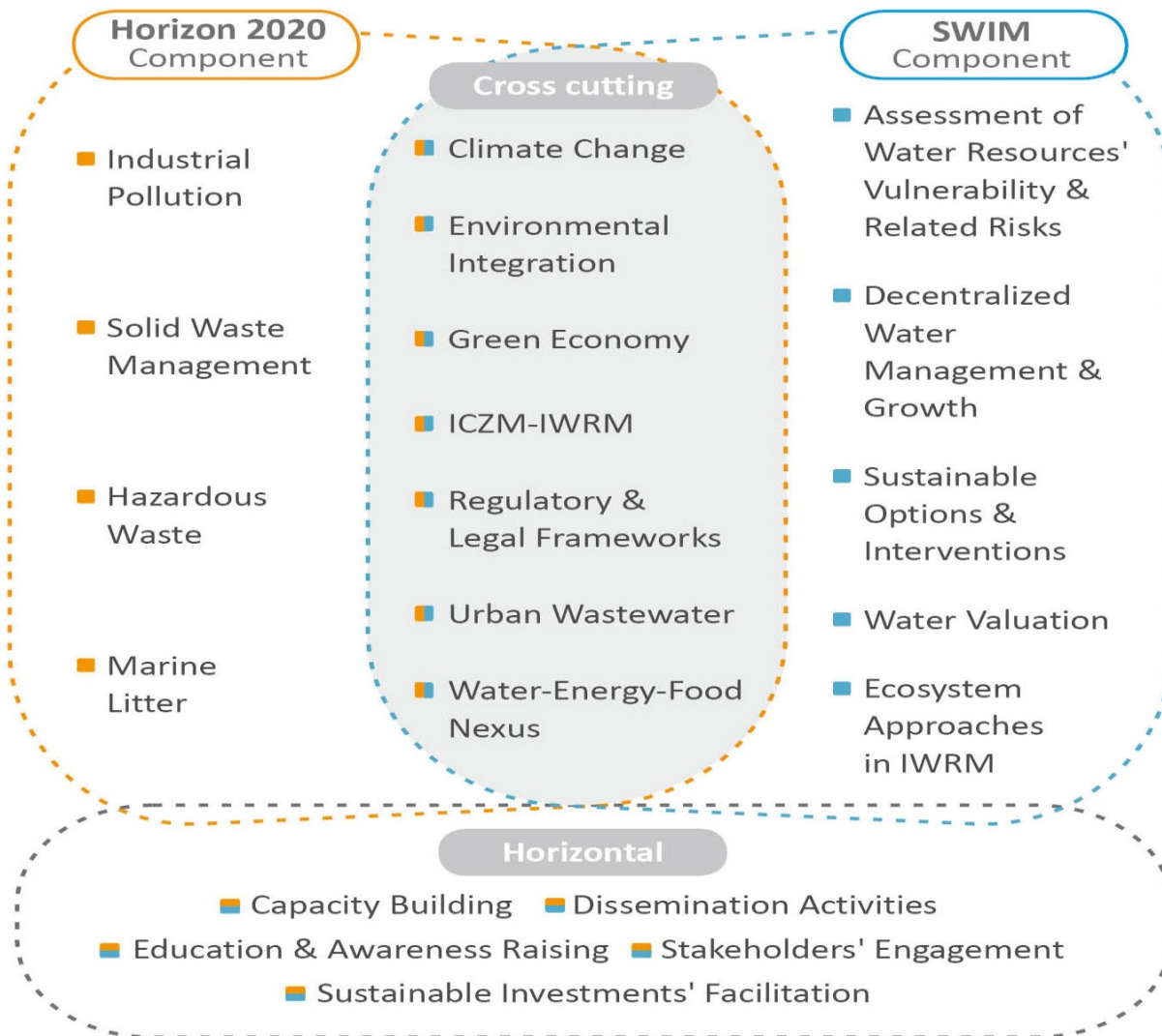

Immediate Outcomes of the Fact-Finding Missions

The Minutes of Country Missions and all the data collected, were compiled and codified per country and compared, enriched, complemented with the written request/lists submitted by the SWIM and H2020 Focal Points after the missions.

559 Requests/480 “eligible”:

125 entries for the H2020 SM

215 entries for the SWIM SM

140 entries that are of common interest

Filtering, synthesis and consolidation followed (taking into account several other factors e.g. the list provided by MeHSIP related to the capacity building needs stemming from their NAPs analysis).

The final priority/request list(s) to be addressed by the project was finalised after thorough study and discussions amongst the Experts Team and selected experts/staff of the Consortium members.

Compilation and codification of countries' priorities

The **criteria** that were used for selection (and clustering) :

- It must be demand driven
- It addresses equitably (almost equally) all and each of the Partner Countries
- It responds, to the extent possible, to the aspirations and requests of the country stakeholders and specifically to the needs of women and youth
- It supports regional processes and the agendas of the relevant Horizon 2020 Initiative's and SWIM institutional partners
- It works in alignment and synergy with bilateral programmes; has a mutually beneficial relationship with other programmes and projects; no duplication of efforts
- It makes the best use of the expertise and resources available to its Consortium members
- It observes the 60/40 balance in resource allocation between the two components: Horizon 2020 SM and SWIM SM
- It is do-able and manageable and, at the end of the day, leaves its “stamp” and legacy in the environmental and water matters of the region

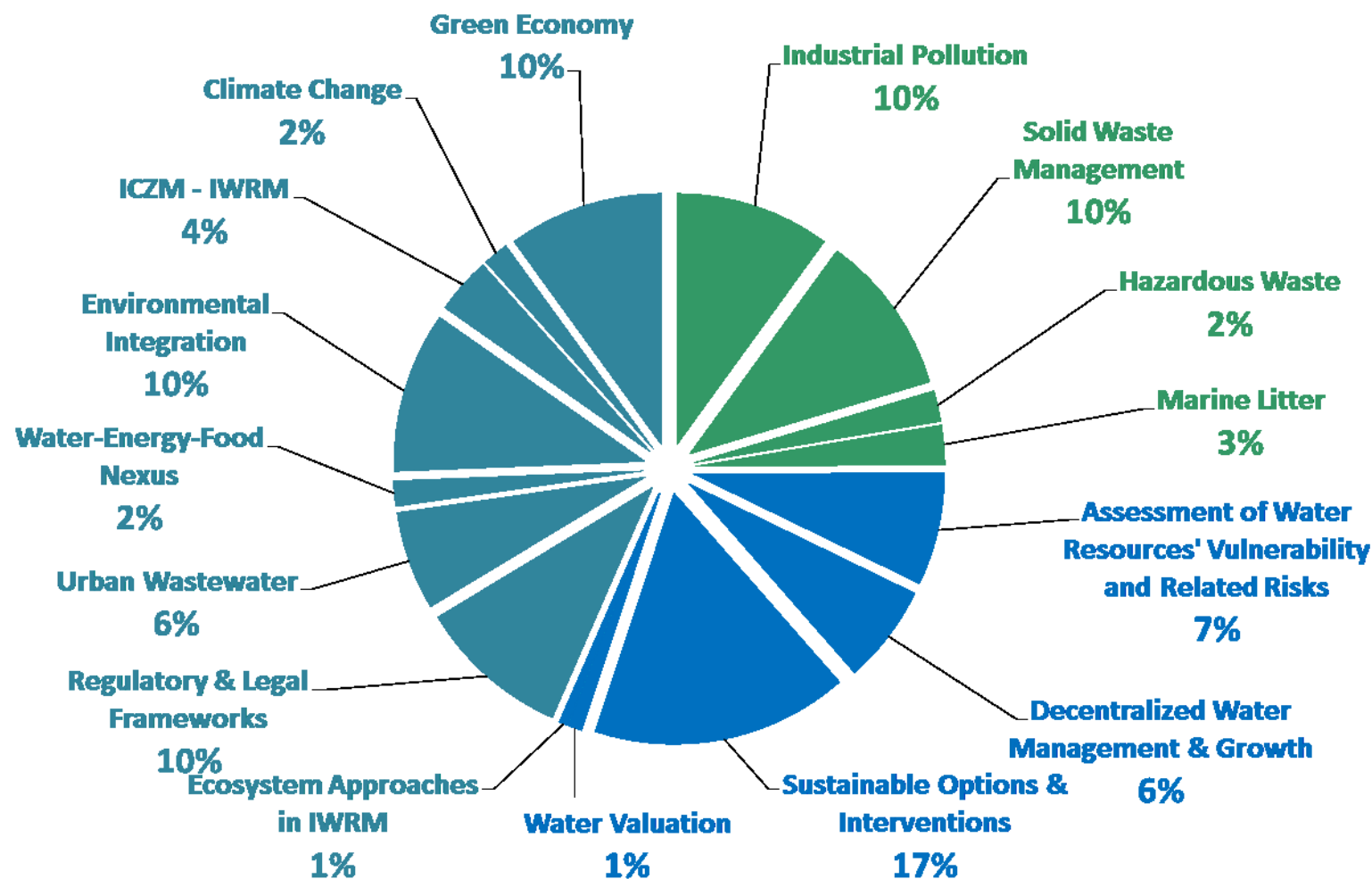

ICZM - IWRM	This new theme supports the <u>integrated management of coastal zones (ICZM) in combination with IWRM</u> , through the application of the Integrative Methodological Framework (IMF), aiming also at enhancing the implementation of the ICZM Protocol of the Barcelona Convention and of the related activities under NAPs;

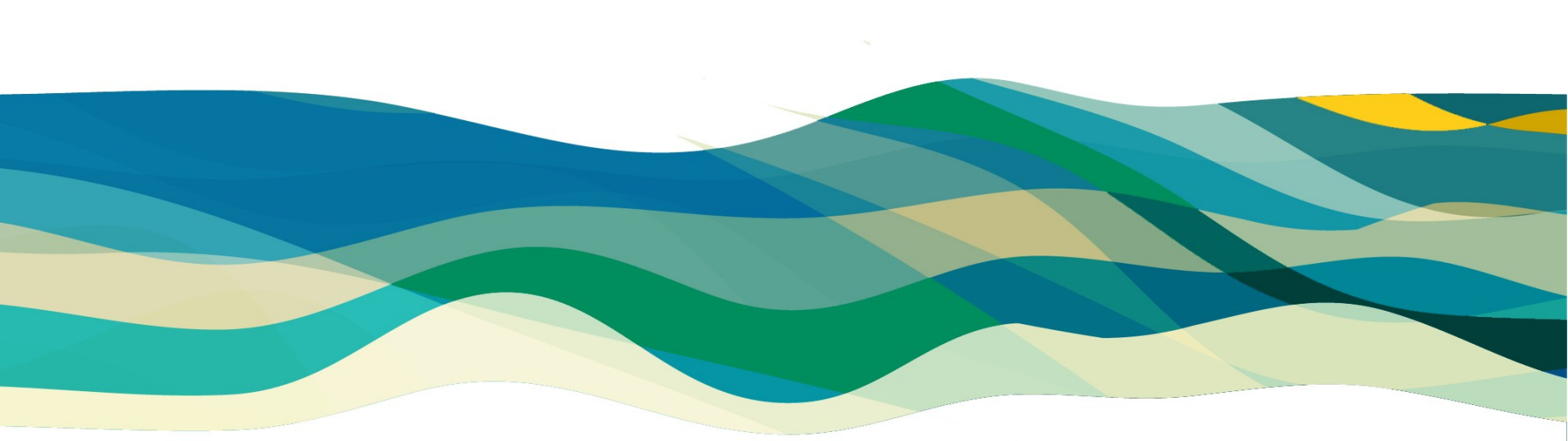
