- 794 K direct beneficiaries (over 5 M indirect beneficiaries) in 2017

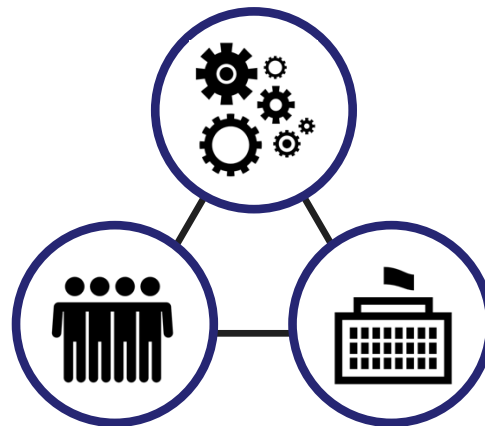
Cesvi in Palestine

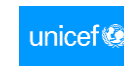

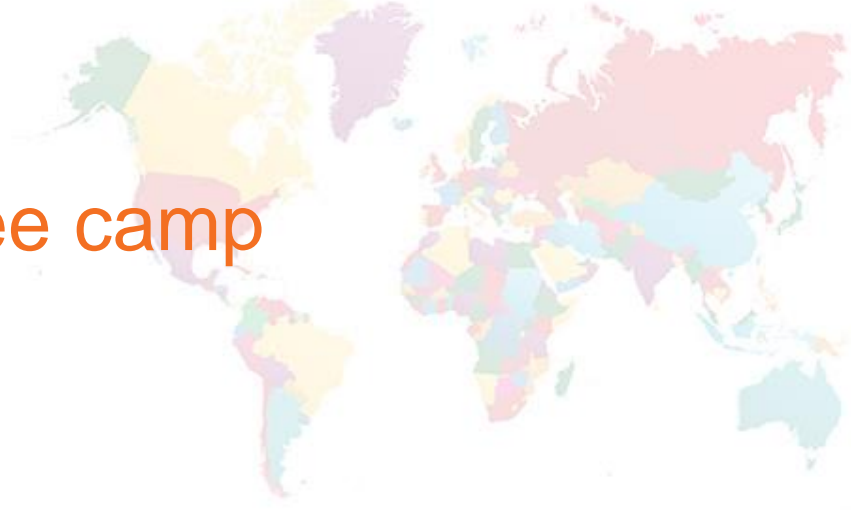

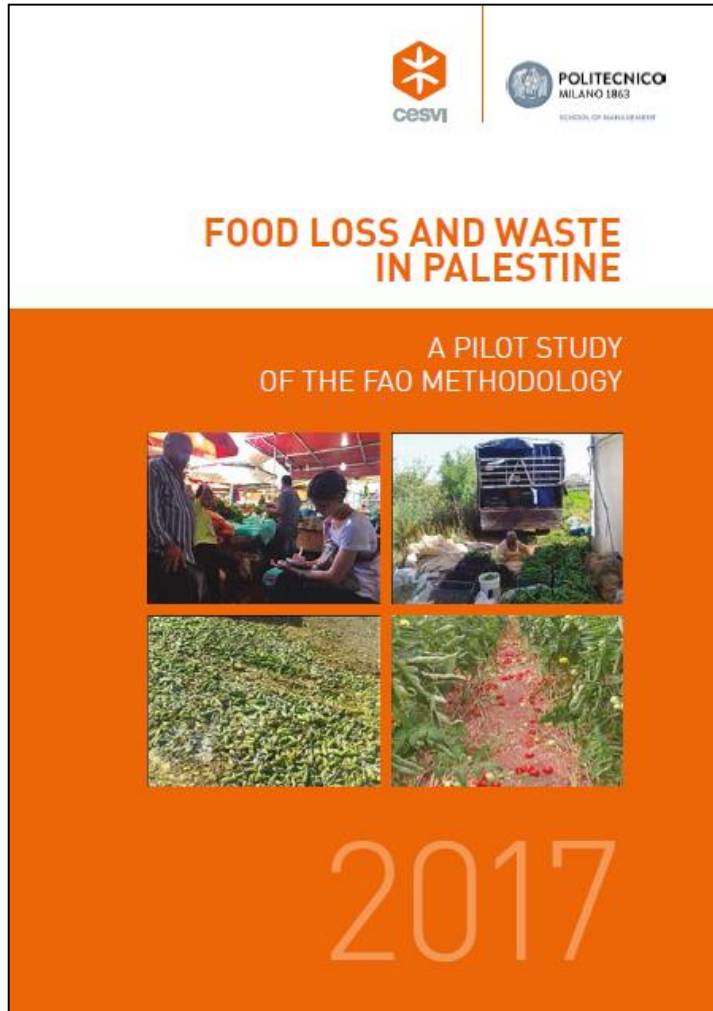
