


SWIM & H2020 SM & MARINE LITTER

- ✓ Enhancing the coordination on marine litter related aspects from monitoring and assessment approaches to prevention and mitigation measures, to concretely support the implementation of the Barcelona Convention Regional Plan for Marine Litter Management in the Mediterranean and the implementation of the European Union Marine Strategy Framework Directive.
- ✓ Complementing the UN Environment/MAP ongoing activities on marine litter focusing on the measures outlined in the Regional Plan e.g. prioritizing and showcasing measures; sharing best practices; developing guidelines, etc.
- ✓ Building synergies with the EU-funded Marine Litter MED project, implemented and coordinated by UN Environment/MAP covering a period of three years (June 2016 – June 2019).
- ✓ Capitalizing on and replicating successful EU (and other) funded initiatives implemented on the science-policy-society interface such the IPA-Adriatic DeFishGear project, the FP7 MARLISCO, the Interreg Med ACT4LITTER project, etc.
- ✓ Advancing and strengthening the implementation of major upcoming programmes such as the 'Plastic Busters for a Mediterranean litter free' project, labeled in 2016 under the Union for the Mediterranean.

- elaboration of an assessment report on amounts, types, composition and sources of marine litter in the surveyed sites).
