Objectives and Outcomes:

Objectives:

- a. Provision of state-of-the-art, demand-driven trainings and tools in identified priority themes at the regional and/or sub-regional and national level
- b. Optimizing the synergies at national and regional level to ensure the highest level of coordination, cooperation and achieving the project overall targets.
- c. Ensuring the continuation and sustainability of synergies during and after the implementation of the project' activities.

Expected impacts:

1. Facilitate dialogue among beneficiaries to offer to participants structured opportunities to learn from each others
2. Empower partners and provide them with the necessary knowledge to follow-up in their countries and further conduct downstream training (ToT)
3. Enhance regional and national exchanges, inspire collaboration between and among countries (south-south, north-south), exploit synergy effects and opportunities

Methodology and Approach of Stakeholders Engagement:

- Stakeholder Mapping and building on the information and experience of previous phases and other programmes and projects.
- Facilitating a dialogue and interchange of experience and knowledge
- Using 2 annual meetings in each country to enhance the synergy and coordination among stakeholders and with other donors and projects
- Establish a mechanism of follow up for sustainability and mainstreaming

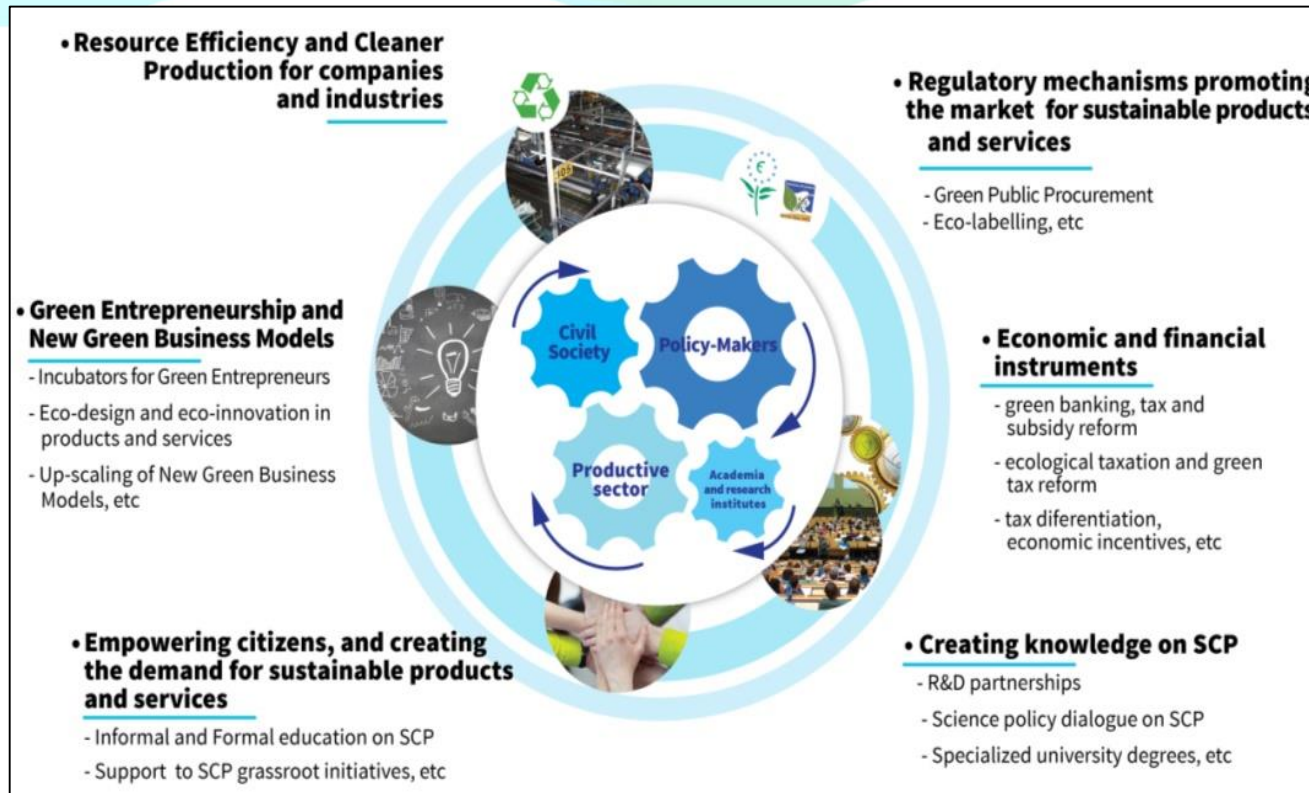

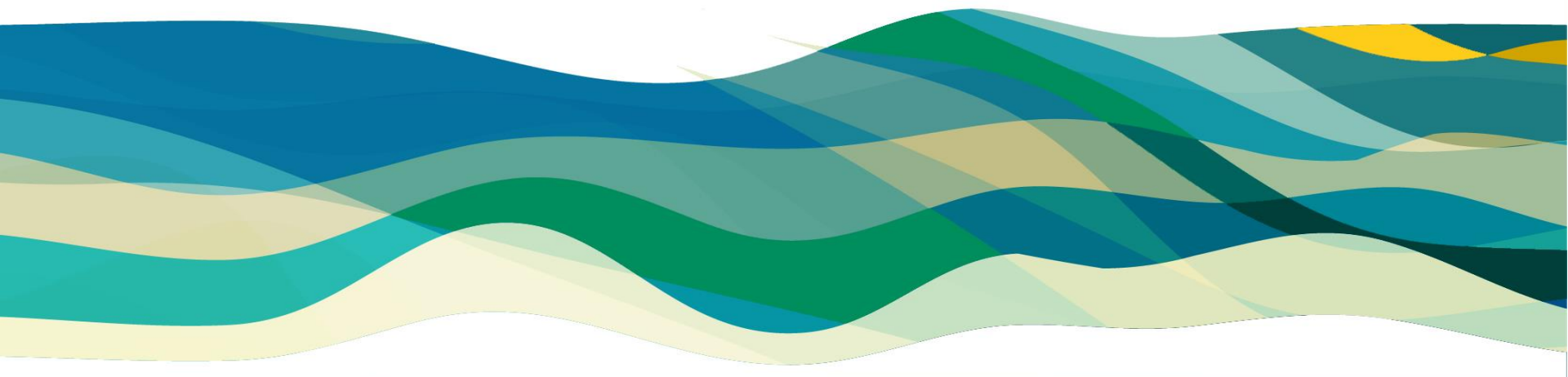

How the SCP/Green Economy, etc. activities will contribute to the region's resilience to CC?



SCP toolbox of measures and key stakeholders (SCP/RAC, 2014)

- The implementation of a combination of measures aiming at improving resource efficiency and creating a circular economy where products are remanufactured, reused, recycled will undoubtedly reduce the GHG emissions on the long term
- ex: Recycling aluminum requires 95% less energy, and produces 95% fewer GHG emissions, than manufacturing primary aluminum
